<u>Preamble:</u> Faculty of Pharmacy in Hradec Králové, Charles University (Czech Republic), together with its project partners from Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna (Italy), University of Pécs (Hungary), University of Porto (Portugal), Comenius University in Bratislava (Slovak Republic), Université de Lorraine (France), University of Ljubljana (Slovenia) and Christian-Albrecht University of Kiel (Germany), announces an Open Call for the participation in the Intense Learner Meeting within the Open access Educational Materials on Naturally Occurring Molecules - sources, biological activity and use (OEMONOM) project supported by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union.

<u>The aim</u> of this intensive study program is to give the students a detailed overview on the topic of vitamins with emphasis on natural and food occurrence, stability in food, symptoms of deficiency, therapeutic use, crucial pharmacokinetic data, and potential toxicity.

Participants

The program is open to students of the partner organizations. Each partner will be able to nominate 2 students who will benefit from the outcomes of the project and will have a unique opportunity to intensively learn about vitamins as well as to spend a week in the company of other foreign students of pharmacy or other biomedical disciplines.

Participation is fully covered by the program. For the selected students, travel, accommodation, and meals will be covered as per the project guidelines.

<u>Who can apply</u>: students of pharmacy or other biomedical disciplines studying both in Master and doctoral programs. The student must however be a student of one of the partner institutions listed above.

<u>Program</u>

During the 1-week event students will be involved in lectures and seminars and will be able to verify their newly gained knowledge in several tests in MOODLE. Accompanying social program will also be prepared for them. <u>Preliminary program is attached here</u>.





Selection process:

Applicants have to send a letter of intent (in English) together with the CV by email to the contact person at their university (see below) by **October 31, 2022 (23:59).** In the CV or letter of intent, student should specify the year of study, type of study, contact email address and phone.

The selection process of 2 participants from each institution will be carried out by a committee of at least three members. Each partner will be responsible for selecting and nominating the students from their university. Selected candidates will be informed about their nominations not later than by mid of **November 2022** by home institution and will be shortly after contacted by organizers from Charles University with further instructions.
